Case no. 82/2026, registered u/s 324(4), 324(5), 326, 308(4) and 3(5) of the BNS.</p> <p>Case has been heard and was posted for an order today. Mr. Vinod Kumar Singh, Ld. counsel on behalf of accused appeared and submitted that applicant is innocent and have not committed any offence and they have falsely been implicated in this case due to grudge and enmity. He further submits that due to land dispute this case has been lodged. The petitioners are ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence their application for anticipatory bail be allowed.</p> <p>Ld. APP appearing on behalf of State has opposed the anticipatory bail application. He argued that matter of an application has been registered under section 324(4), 324(5), 326, 308(4) and 3(5) of the BNS. He argued that Dinara P.S. Case no. 160/2025 is lodged against the petitioner Vishwajeet Kharwar, Abhishek Kumar and Avinash Kumar. The instant case has been filed against the petitioners for the offence punishable under sections 324(4), 324(5), 326, 308(4) and 3(5) of the BNS.</p> <p>On perusal of Para 35 of case diary prima facie reveals that the petitioners have one criminal antecedent. Informant (Para 05) and the witnesses in para 06, 07 and 07 of the case diary has supported the case that the petitioners wants to grab the land of the informant and for that they are causing mischief. They are also threatening the informant who is senior citizen, to transfer his piece of land. The diary also disclosed that the same land stands in the name of of the informant's father late Ambika Kharwar.</p> <p>Considering the above enumerated facts & circumstances and criminal antecedent, This court not found apt case for anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners stands refused.</p> <p>Let a copy of this order be transmitted to Ld. Court below forthwith.
