01.06.2026	An anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused petitioners namely (1) Parashuram Paswan (2) Babuli Paswan (3) Anil Paswan (4) Vishram Paswan @ Butan who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Suryapura P.S Case No. 71/2026, registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 303(2), 352, 351(2) and 3(5) of BNS, 2023. Case has been heard and was posted for an order today. Mr. Ram Naresh Singh, Ld. counsel on behalf of accused appeared and submitted that applicant is innocent and have not committed any offence and they have falsely been implicated in this case due to vilage politics and previous enmity. He further submits that this case is lodged only a view to save their neck from Dihari Harijan P.S Case No. 11/2026. The petitioners are ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence their application for anticipatory bail be allowed. Ld. APP appearing on behalf of State has opposed the anticipatory bail application. He argued that matter of an application has been registered under section 126(2), 115(2), 109, 303(2), 352, 351(2) and 3(5) of BNS, 2023. Hence the instant anticipatory bail application be rejected. Perused the record of case and material available on record. From perusal it transpires that the instant case has been filed on the written application of informant namely Ramawadh Singh. The instant case has been filed against the petitioners for the offence punishable under sections 126(2), 115(2), 109, 303(2), 352, 351(2) and 3(5) of BNS, 2023.	

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Cont..... 01.06.2026	On perusal of para no. 14 of the case dairy, It prima facie reveals that injuries are simple in nature. Para 17 of case dairy prima facie reveals that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent. Moreover there is case and counter case between the parties. Considering the above enumerated facts & circumstances and lack of criminal antecedent, the prayer for bail of the petitioners stands allowed. Let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below in the event of arrest or surrender with direction that the petitioners shall cooperate with the trial and make himself available as and when so required and in case of failure, the court shall be at liberty to cancel bail. The petitioners are directed remain present physically till framing of charge. Let a copy of this order be transmitted to Ld. Court below forthwith.
