04.07.2026	An anticipatory bail petition (160/2026) and second anticipatory bail petition (165/2026) has been filed on behalf of accused petitioners namely (1) Abhishekh Kumar @ Abhishek Kumar (2) Suman Kumar (3) Surendra Singh (4) Sudama Singh @ Bhuwar (5) Anil Kumar (6) Dharendra Kumar and (1) Mukesh Kumar (2) Sharawan Kumar (3) Munna Singh (4) Ravindra Kumar @ Pravind Kumar respectively who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Sanjhauli P.S Case No. 48/2026, registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS, 2023 Case has been heard and was posted for an order today. Both case are disposed off with this common order for convenience. Md. Shashi Kant Dubey , Ld. counsel on behalf of accused petitioner appeared and submitted that applicant is innocent and has not committed any offence and they have falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that the petitioners have never gone to the door of the informant. The petitioner is ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence his application for anticipatory bail be allowed. Ld. APP appearing on behalf of State has opposed the anticipatory bail application. He argued that matter of an application has been registered under sections registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS, 2023. He argues that Sanjhauli P.S Case No. 157/2023 is registered against Suman Kumar and Mukesh Kumar, Sanjhauli P.S Case No. 88/2022 and 157/2023 is registered against Surendra Singh and Sanjhauli P.S Case No. 82/2020 88/2022, 157/2023 and 115/2020 is registered against Ravindra Kumar @ Pravind Kumar Hence the instant anticipatory bail application be rejected. Perused the record of case and material available on record. From perusal it transpires	

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Cont..... 04.07.2026	that the instant case has been filed on the written application of informant namely Kamlesh Pasi. The instant case has been filed against the petitioners and others for the offence punishable under sections 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS, 2023. On perusal of Para 33 and 34 of the case diary , It transpires that the petitioners has two criminal antecedent in their account. As per para no. 54 and 55 of the case diary, it prima facie revels that injuries are simple in nature. More over there is case and counter case between the parties which is registered as Sanjhauli P.S Case No. 47 //2026 and 48/2026 Considering the above enumerated facts & circumstances and injuries sustained, the prayer for bail of the petitioners stands allowed. Let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below in the event of arrest or surrender with direction that the petitioners shall cooperate with the trial and make himself available as and when so required and in case of failure, the court shall be at liberty to cancel bail. The petitioners will remain physically present on each date till framing of charge. Let a copy of this order be transmitted to Ld. Court below forthwith.
