04.07.2026	An anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused petitioners namely (1) Kamlesh Pasi (2) Sanjay Pasi @ Sanjay Ram (3) Purshotam Kumar (4) Ajay Pasi @ Ajay Kumar who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Sanjhauli P.S Case No. 49/2026, registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS, 2023. Case has been heard and was posted for an order today. Mr Ram Naresh Singh, Ld. counsel on behalf of accused appeared and submitted that applicant is innocent and have not committed any offence and they have falsely been implicated in this case due to some annoyance, village politics and land dispute. He further submits that this case is counter case of Sanjhauli P.S Case No. 48/2026 only with a view to save his neck. The petitioners are ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence their application for anticipatory bail be allowed. Ld. APP appearing on behalf of State has opposed the anticipatory bail application. He argued that matter of an application has been registered under sections 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS, 2023. He argues that Sanjhauli P.S Case No. 81/2020 is registered against the petitioners and Sanjhauli P.S Case No. 67/2020 is registered against Ajay Pasi and Sanjhauli P.S Case No. 98/2021 is pending against Purshotam kumar. Hence the instant anticipatory bail application be rejected. Perused the record of case and material available on record. From perusal it transpires that the instant case has been filed on the written application of informant namely Reshma Devi. The instant case has been filed against the petitioners	

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Cont..... 04.07.2026	for the offence punishable under sections 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS, 2023. As per para 16 of the case diary, the petitioners has antecedent in their account. As per para no 22 of the case diary, it prima facie revels that injuries are simple in nature. More over there is case and counter case between the parties which is registered as Sanjhauli P.S Case No. 47 //2026 and 48/2026 Considering the above enumerated facts & circumstances and injuries sustained, the prayer for bail of the petitioners stands allowed. Let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below in the event of arrest or surrender with direction that the petitioners shall cooperate with the trial and make himself available as and when so required and in case of failure, the court shall be at liberty to cancel bail. The petitioners will remain physically present on each date till framing of charge. Let a copy of this order be transmitted to Ld. Court below forthwith.
