16.06.2026	An anticipatory bail petition (220/2026) and second anticipatory bail petition (221/2026) has been filed on behalf of accused petitioners namely (1) Imteyaz Ansari and (1) Aftab Ansari (2) Sayed Ansari (3) Nazrina Khatoon (4) Kalamuddin Ansari respectively who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Karakat P.S. Case no. 111/2026, registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 85, 3(5) of BNS and 3 & 4 of DP Act. Case has been heard and was posted for an order today. Both case are disposed off with this common order for convenience. Md. Ali Khan, Ld. counsel on behalf of accused petitioner appeared and submitted that applicant is innocent and has not committed any offence and they have falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that petitioners have not asked for dowry and have not done any type of violence with the informant. The petitioner is ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence his application for anticipatory bail be allowed. Ld. APP appearing on behalf of State has opposed the anticipatory bail application. He argued that matter of an application has been registered under sections registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 85, 3(5) of BNS and 3 & 4 of DP Act. Hence the instant anticipatory bail application be rejected. Perused the record of case and material available on record. From perusal it transpires that the instant case has been filed on the written application of informant namely Soni Khatoon. The instant case has been filed against the petitioners for the offence punishable under sections 126(2), 115(2), 85, 3(5) of BNS and 3 & 4 of DP Act. ABP 220/26 has been filed on behalf of husband of informant and ABP 221/26 has been filed

After receiving of the Case record, a notice was issued to the informant of Case and she appeared through her lawyer. The parties settled their dispute in amicable manner and to this effect a petition dated 06/05/2026 has been filed. As per petition, the complainant is leading happy married life with her husband and in laws. On perusal of LCR, it transpires that the allegations are omnibus in nature. More over the case is triable by the Magistrate. Apex Court in Arnesh Kumar case, dealing with the issue of “deliberate and rampant misuse of provisions of Section 498-A of IPC as a tool of harassment by a disgruntled wife has pleased issued guide line to court. Petitioner claims clean antecedent on affidavit. Considering the above enumerated facts and circumstances, the prayer for bail of the petitioners stands allowed. Let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below in the event of arrest or surrender with direction that the petitioners shall cooperate with the trial and make himself available as and when so required and in case of failure, the court shall be at liberty to cancel bail. The petitioners will remain physically present on each date till framing of charge. Let a copy of this order be transmitted to Ld. Court below forthwith.
