01.06.2026	An anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused petitioner namely Om Prakash Singh who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Natwar P.S. Case no. 167/2025, registered u/s 127(1), 115(2), 303(2), 352, 351(2) of the BNS. Case has been heard and was posted for an order today. Mr. Shiv Kumar Singh, Ld. counsel on behalf of accused appeared and submitted that applicant is innocent and have not committed any offence and they have falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that this case is lodged only a view to save their neck from Natwar P.S Case No. 62/2026. he further submits that occurrence is said to be happened on 06.09.2025 but the matter has been reported on 16.09.2025. The petitioner is ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence his application for anticipatory bail be allowed. Ld. APP appearing on behalf of State has opposed the anticipatory bail application. He argued that matter of an application has been registered under section 127(1), 115(2), 303(2), 352, 351(2) of the BNS. He argues that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent except Natwar P.S Case No. 27/2020. Hence the instant anticipatory bail application be rejected. Perused the record of case and material available on record. From perusal it transpires that the instant case has been filed on the written application of informant namely Saroj Devi. The instant case has been filed against the petitioner for the offence punishable under section 127(1), 115(2), 303(2), 352, 351(2) of the BNS.	

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Cont..... 01.06.2026	On perusal of Para 38 of case dairy prima facie revels that the petitioner has one as antecedent in his account. On perusal of Para 38 of case dairy prima facie revels that the petitioner house was searched for alleged theft property and during said search , no incriminating material was recovered. Para 59 of the case diary shows that the informant of the has not received any medical treatment either in government hospital or with any registered medical practitioner. Considering the above enumerated facts & circumstances and non recovery of theft property form the possession of the petitioner, the prayer for bail of the petitioners stands allowed. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below in the event of arrest or surrender with direction that the petitioner shall cooperate with the trial and make himself available as and when so required and in case of failure, the court shall be at liberty to cancel bail. The petitioner is further directed to remain present in the court till framing of charge. Let a copy of this order be transmitted to Ld. Court below forthwith.
