05.06.2026	Bail application along with power on behalf of Petitioners (1) Deepak Kumar Singh (2) Saroj Singh (3) Nand Kumar @ Nand Kumar Singh (4) Khaderan Mahto and (5) Maya Devi who are in judicial custody since 15.04.2026 in connection with Nasriganj P.S Case No. 126/2026, registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 303(2), 3(5) of BNS. Case has been heard and was posted for an order today. Mr. Bijay Prasad, Learned counsel for petitioners have submitted that petitioners are innocent have committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that there is a land dispute between the petitioner and the informant. He further submits that Nasriganj P.S Case No. 125/2026 is registered by the petitioner no. 01 against the informant and this case has been lodged only to save their neck. They are ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence their application for bail be allowed. Ld. APP appearing on behalf of State has opposed the bail application. He argued that FIR has been registered under sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 303(2), 3(5) of BNS and custody of accused person is required for investigation and unfolding the crimes committed by them. He argued that a bail petition of the petitioner have been rejected by the SDJM, Bikramganj vide order dt. 21.04.2026 Hence the instant bail application be rejected. Heard both the parties and perused the record of case and material available on record. From perusal it transpires that the instant case has been registered on the written application of informant namely Shivjee Singh. The instant case has been filed against the petitioners and nine others for the offence punishable under sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 303(2), 3(5) of BNS.	

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Contd..... 05.06.2026	From the perusal it transpired that the petitioner is in custody since 15/04/2026. As per para 60 of the case diary, the petitioner has no antecedent in his account. As per para 61 of the case dairy and medical report attached therein , prima facie revels that the injuries are simple in nature. Considering the above enumerated facts & circumstances, nature of injuries sustained and period of incarceration of the petitioners, the prayer for bail of the petitioners stands allowed. Let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below with direction that the petitioners shall cooperate with the trial and make himself available as and when so required and in case of failure, the court shall be at liberty to cancel bail. The petitioner will remain present in the court physically till framing of charge. Let a copy of this order be transmitted to Ld. Court below forthwith.
