05.06.2026	Bail application along with power has been filed on behalf of Petitioner Ajay Kumar @ Ajay Chaudhary who is in judicial custody since 07.02.2026 in connection with Sanjhauli P.S Case No. 175/2025, registered u/s 303(2) of BNS 2023. Case has been heard and was posted for an order today. Mr. Radheshyam Singh, Learned counsel for petitioner have submitted that petitioners are innocent has committed no offence and he has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that nothing has been recovered from the petitioner and he was not arrested on spot his name only came on the confessional statement of co-accused Aman Kumar. He is ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence his application for bail be allowed. Ld. APP appearing on behalf of State has opposed the bail application. He argued that FIR has been registered under sections 303(2) of BNS 2023 and custody of accused person is required for investigation and unfolding the crimes committed by them. He argued that four cases i.e, Sanjhauli P.S Case No. 56/2022, 166/23, 225/24 and Hasan Bazar P.S Case No. 104/2025 is registered against the petitioner. Hence the instant bail application be rejected. Heard both the parties and perused the record of case and material available on record. From perusal it transpires that the instant case has been registered on the written application of informant namely Arvind Kumar. The instant case has been filed against petitioner for the offence punishable under sections 303(2) of BNS 2023. From perusal of FIR it transpires that the case has been registered against the unknown persons and the name of the petitioner appears on the confessional statement of Aman Kumar (Para 28 of the	

Contd..... 05.06.2026	CD). The case diary is silent over the criminal antecedent of the petitioner but the he has disclosed his antecedent in the petition. No theft article has been recovered from his possession. In this case charge sheet has been submitted and charge has framed and case is fixed for evidence. Moreover the petitioner is in custody since 26.09.2025. Considering the above enumerated facts & circumstances and period of incarceration of the petitioner, the prayer for bail of the petitioner stands allowed. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below with direction that the petitioners shall cooperate with the trial and make himself available as and when so required and in case of failure, the court shall be at liberty to cancel bail. The petitioner will remain present in the court physically till framing of charge. Let a copy of this order along with LCR be transmitted to Ld. Court below forthwith.
