10.06.2026	An anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused petitioners namely (1) Rajiv Kumar (2) Hemant Kumar who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Dinara P.S. Case no. 169/2026, registered u/s 126(2), 303(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS. Case has been heard and was posted for an order today. Mr Sushil Kumar Singh, Ld. counsel on behalf of accused appeared and submitted that applicant is innocent and have not committed any offence and they have falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that the has filed complaint case no. 230/2026. The petitioners are ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence their application for anticipatory bail be allowed. Ld. APP appearing on behalf of State has opposed the anticipatory bail application. He argued that matter of an application has been registered under sections 126(2), 303(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS. Hence the instant anticipatory bail application be rejected. Perused the record of case and material available on record. From perusal it transpires that the instant case has been filed on the written application of informant namely Rajendra Singh. The instant case has been filed against the petitioners and four others for the offence punishable under sections 126(2), 303(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS. Case diary has been called from BP 179/2026. As per para 39 of the case diary, the petitioner has no criminal antecedent in his account. As per para 40 of the case dairy the injuries sustained

Supplementary report shows that patient Rajendar Singh had not gone to Sadar hospital for head CT scan and x-ray report shows normal study. Moreover there is case counter case between the paries. Considering the above enumerated facts & circumstances and lack of criminal antecedent of the petitioners, the prayer for bail of the petitioners stands allowed. Let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below in the event of arrest or surrender with direction that the petitioners shall cooperate with the trial and make himself available as and when so required and in case of failure, the court shall be at liberty to cancel bail.
