04.06.2026	Bail application along with power on behalf of Petitioners (1) Gorakh Paswan @ Gorakh Ram (2) Hareram Paswan (3) Ritesh Paswan (4) Santosh Paswan who are in judicial custody since 07.05.2026 in connection with Rajpur P.S Case No. 81/2026, registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 351(3), 3(5) of BNS. Case has been heard and was posted for an order today. Mr. Lal Babu Dubey, Learned counsel for petitioners have submitted that petitioners are innocent have committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that Rajpur P.S Case No. 102/2025 is registered by the petitioner no. 01 against the informant and he want to compromise the case but when the petitioner did not compromise this false case is lodged. They are ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence their application for bail be allowed. Ld. APP appearing on behalf of State has opposed the bail application. He argued that FIR has been registered under sections 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 351(3), 3(5) of BNS and custody of accused person is required for investigation and unfolding the crimes committed by them. He argues that Rajpur P.S Case No. 28/2026 is registered against petitioner no. 02 in which he is on bail. Hence the instant bail application be rejected. Heard both the parties and perused the record of case and material available on record. From perusal it transpires that the instant case has been registered on the written application of informant namely Dadan Kumar. The instant case has been filed against the petitioner and ten others for the offence punishable under sections 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 351(3), 3(5) of BNS. From the perusal it transpired that the petitioner is in custody since	

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07/05/2026. As per para 15 of the case diary, the petitioner has no antecedent in his account except Hare Ram who has one case as criminal antecedent in which he is on bail. As per para 37 of the case dairy, prima facie reveals that the injuries are on head but are simple in nature.

Considering the above enumerated facts & circumstances and period of incarceration of the petitioner, the prayer for bail of the petitioner **stands allowed.**

Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below with direction that the petitioners shall cooperate with the trial and make himself available as and when so required and in case of failure, the court shall be at liberty to cancel bail. The petitioner will remain present in the court physically till framing of charge.

Let a copy of this order be transmitted to Ld. Court below forthwith. O/C is directed to deposit the record as per rules.
