14.07.2026	Bail application along with power has been filed on behalf of Petitioner Lalti Devi who is in judicial custody since 04.04.2026 in connection with Karakat P.S. Case no. 156/2026, registered u/s 103(1), 238, 3(5) of the BNS . Case has been heard and was posted for an order today. Mr. Shashi Bhusan Singh, Ld. counsel on behalf of accused appeared and submitted that applicant is innocent and have not committed any offence and they have falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that the petitioner is mother of co-accused Pintu Kumar. He is ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence his application for bail be allowed. Ld. APP appearing on behalf of State has opposed the bail application. He argued that FIR has been registered under sections 103(1), 238, 3(5) of the BNS and custody of accused person is required for investigation and unfolding the crimes committed by them. He argued that a regular bail petition of the petitioner has been rejected by A.C.J.M. 1st, Bikramganj vide order dated 11.05.2026. Hence the instant bail application be rejected. Heard both the parties and perused the record of case and material available on record. From perusal it transpires that the instant case has been registered on the written application of informant namely Dharmu Bhuia. The instant case has been filed against the petitioner and seven others for the offence punishable under sections 103(1), 238, 3(5) of the BNS. Prosecution story in nut shell is that due to being issue-less, the daughter of the informant was killed by the petitioner and other co-accused persons. They also causes to disappear the dead body of the daughter of the informant by burning, with the intention of screening themselves from punishment. The petitioner is mother-in-law of the deceased.	

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On perusal of case diary, it transpires that informant in his further statement at para 02 of CD and other witnesses at para 04, 05, 06, 07 of CD have supported the prosecution version of the case. The petitioner is of clear antecedent. Accused is in judicial custody since 04/04/2026 and charge sheet has submitted against him.

Considering the facts stated above and gravity of offence, This court is not inclined to grant bail to this petitioner. Accordingly prayer for bail stands **rejected**.
