01.07.2026	Bail application along with power on behalf of Petitioners (1) Sadik Ansari (2) Sakiya Khatoon @ Sakila Khatoon (3) Khusboo Khatoon who are in judicial custody since 19.05.2026 in connection with Dinara P.S Case No. 206/2026, registered u/s 126(2), 352, 351(2), 117(2), 74, 303(2), 109, 115(2), 3(5) of BNS. Case has been heard and was posted for an order today. Mr. Gopal Krishna Bhardwaj, Learned counsel for petitioners have submitted that petitioners are innocent have committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case due to grudge and high handedness of police authority. They are ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence their application for bail be allowed. Ld. APP appearing on behalf of State has opposed the bail application. He argued that FIR has been registered under sections 126(2), 352, 351(2), 117(2), 74, 303(2), 109, 115(2), 3(5) of BNS and custody of accused person is required for investigation and unfolding the crimes committed by them. He argued that a bail petition of the petitioner have been rejected by the SDJM, Bikramganj vide order dt. 23.05.2026. Hence the instant bail application be rejected. Heard both the parties and perused the record of case and material available on record. From perusal it transpires that the instant case has been registered on the written application of informant namely Rajiya Begum. The instant case has been filed against the petitioners and seven others for the offence punishable under sections 126(2), 352, 351(2), 117(2), 74, 303(2), 109, 115(2), 3(5) of BNS. On perusal of the case dairy and FIR, It appears that there is quarrel between the women of both side. The case diary is silent over the antecedent	

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of the petitioners. The petitioners claims clean antecedent on affidavit and nothing adverse has been brought on record during the course of argument. On perusal of para 35 of the case dairy, it is presumed that injuries would be simple in nature as no injury report is available with diary. The petitioners are in judicial custody since 19/06/2026 and more over two petitioners are women.

Considering the above enumerated facts & circumstances, lack of criminal antecedent and period of incarceration of the petitioners, the prayer for bail of the petitioner **stands allowed**.

Let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below with direction that the petitioners shall cooperate with the trial and make himself available as and when so required and in case of failure, the court shall be at liberty to cancel bail. The petitioner will remain present in the court physically till framing of charge.

Let a copy of this order be transmitted to Ld. Court below forthwith. O/C is directed to deposit the record as per rules.
