17.06.2026	Bail application along with power has been filed on behalf of Petitioner Jainudin Sai @ Jainudin Sah who is in judicial custody since 23.05.2025 in connection with Suryapura P.S Case No. 50/2004, registered u/s 461, 379, 411 of IPC. Case has been heard and was posted for an order today. Mr. Ram Naresh Singh, Learned counsel for petitioner have submitted that petitioner is illiterate person and he work as a labourer at Kolkata and he did not know about the process of case and dated so he did not present on date fixed. He is ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence his application for bail be allowed. Ld. APP appearing on behalf of State has opposed the bail application. He argued that FIR has been registered under sections 461, 379, 411 of IPC. and custody of accused person is required for trial the crimes committed by him. He had misused the privilege granted to him. He argued that a bail petition of the petitioner have been rejected by the SDJM, Bikramganj vide order dt. 23.05.2026. Hence the instant bail application be rejected. Heard both the parties and perused the record of case and material available on record. From perusal it transpires that the instant case has been registered on the written application of informant namely Shivjee Singh. The instant case has been filed against petitioner and two others for the offence punishable under sections 461, 379,	

Contd..... 17.06.2026	411 of IPC. From the perusal it transpired that the petitioner is in custody since 23/05/2025. In the case at hand it appears that prosecution evidence has been closed and statement of accused person has been recorded on 27/09/2024. service report is also not available at record. Considering the above enumerated facts & circumstances and period of incarceration of the petitioner, the prayer for bail of the petitioner stands allowed. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below with direction that the petitioners shall cooperate with the trial and make himself available as and when so required and in case of failure, the court shall be at liberty to cancel bail. The petitioner is further directed to remain present in the court physically till disposal of the case. Let a copy of this order along with LCR be transmitted to Ld. Court below forthwith.
