27.04.2026	<p>An anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused petitioners namely (1) Bittu Patel (2) Manoj Chaudhary (3) Suresh Chaudhary (4) Batesra Kuwar (5) Indu Devi (6) Aman Patel (7) Ritik Patel who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Suryapura P.S. Case no. 176/2025, registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 85, 89, 351(2), 352 and 3(5) of the BNS and 3 / 4 of D.P Act.</p> <p>Case has been heard and was posted for an order today. Mr. Kishor Kumar Kamal, Ld. counsel on behalf of accused appeared and submitted that applicant is innocent and have not committed any offence and they have falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that the case has been amicably settled between the parties. The petitioners are ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence their application for anticipatory bail be allowed.</p> <p>Ld. APP appearing on behalf of State has opposed the anticipatory bail application. He argued that matter of an application has been registered under section 126(2), 115(2), 85, 89, 351(2), 352 and 3(5) of the BNS and 3 / 4 of D.P Act. Hence the instant anticipatory bail application be rejected.</p> <p>Perused the record of case and material available on record. From perusal it transpires that the instant case has been filed on the written application of informant namely Sheshmi Kumari. The instant case has been filed against the petitioners for the offence punishable under sections 126(2), 115(2), 85, 89, 351(2), 352 and 3(5) of the BNS and 3 / 4 of D.P Act.</p> <p>After receiving of the Case record, a notice was issued to the informant and she appeared through her lawyer Sri Gollu Kumar. With intervention of the court, Parties settled the dispute in amicable manner and accordingly a compromise petition has been filed. .</p>

Apex Court in Arnesh Kumar case, dealing with the issue of “deliberate and rampant misuse of provisions of Section 498-A of IPC as a tool of harassment by a disgruntled wife has pleased issued guide line to court. Petitioners claims clean antecedent on affidavit and nothing adverse has been brought on record during hearing from the side of the prosecution.</p> <p>Considering the above enumerated facts & circumstances and lack of criminal antecedent, the prayer for bail of the petitioners stands allowed.</p> <p>Let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below in the event of arrest or surrender with direction that the petitioners shall cooperate with the trial and make himself available as and when so required and in case of failure, the court shall be at liberty to cancel bail. They are further directed to remain present in the court till framing of charge.</p> <p>Let a copy of this order be transmitted to Ld. Court below forthwith.
