Case no. 141/2023, registered u/s 147, 149, 341, 323, 325, 307, 504, 379 of I.P.C.</p> <p>Case has been heard and was posted for an order today. Uma Shankar Chaudhary, Ld. counsel on behalf of accused appeared and submitted that applicant is innocent and have not committed any offence and they have falsely been implicated in this case due to previous enmity. The petitioners are ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence their application for anticipatory bail be allowed.</p> <p>Ld. APP appearing on behalf of State has opposed the anticipatory bail application. He argued that matter of an application has been registered under section 147, 149, 341, 323, 325, 307, 504, 379 of I.P.C. From perusal it transpires that the instant case has been filed on the written application of informant namely Nirmal Singh. Court below in the event of arrest or surrender with direction that the petitioners shall cooperate with the trial and make himself available as and when so required and in case of failure, the court shall be at liberty to cancel bail. They are further directed to remain present in the court till framing of charge.</p> <p>Let a copy of this order be transmitted to Ld. Court below forthwith.
