Sri Ramesh Chandra Upadhyay, Ld. counsel on behalf of accused petitioner appeared and submitted that applicant is innocent and has not committed any offence and he has falsely been implicated in this case due to non-full fillment of illegal demand made by offices concerned. The petitioner is ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence his application for anticipatory bail be allowed.</p> <p>Ld.
