10.03.2026	<p>An anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused petitioners namely (1) Sonu Kumar (2) Indrajit Singh who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Suryapura P.S. Case no. 254/2025, registered u/s 64, 81, 3(5) of BNS, 2023.</p> <p>Case has been heard and was posted for an order today. Md. Pavan Kumar Singh, Ld. counsel on behalf of accused appeared and submitted that applicant is innocent and have not committed any offence and they have falsely been implicated in this case due to wrongful gain. He further submits that victim Pushpa Kumari has married with Sonu Kumar and she is living with him in his sasural. The petitioners are ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence their application for anticipatory bail be allowed.</p> <p>Ld. APP appearing on behalf of State has opposed the anticipatory bail application. He argued that matter of an application has been registered under sections 64, 81, 3(5) of BNS, 2023. Hence the instant anticipatory bail application be rejected.</p> <p>Perused the record of case and material available on record. From perusal it transpires that the instant case has been filed on the written application of informant namely Udayshankar Singh. The instant case has been filed against the petitioners and three others for the offence punishable under sections 64, 81, 3(5) of BNS, 2023.</p> <p>On perusal of para 81 of the case diary the petitioners are of clean antecedent. Marriage has been solemnized between Puspa Kumari d/o Uday Shankar Singh and Sonu Kumar s/o Indrajeet Singh and after that the parties has settled the dispute amicably and to this effect a petition has been filed.</p>

Court below in the event of arrest or surrender with direction that the petitioners shall cooperate with the trial and make himself available as and when so required and in case of failure, the court shall be at liberty to cancel bail.</p> <p>Let a copy of this order be transmitted to Ld.
