15.04.2026	An anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused petitioner namely Ranjan @ Kumar Ranjan who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Comp Case no. 100/2025, registered u/s 85, 115(2), 126(2), 352 of BNS and 3 / 4 of D.P Act. Case has been heard and was posted for an order today. Mr. Santosh Kumar Srivastava, Ld. counsel on behalf of accused appeared and submitted that applicant is innocent and have not committed any offence and they have falsely been implicated in this case only to harrass and humiliate the petitioner, his old widow mother and relative. He further submits that the petitioner has already filed a matrimonial case no. 169/2025 in family court, Sasaram. The petitioner is ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence his application for anticipatory bail be allowed. Ld. APP appearing on behalf of State has opposed the anticipatory bail application. He argued that matter of an application has been registered under section 85, 115(2), 126(2), 352 of BNS and 3 / 4 of D. P Act. Hence the instant anticipatory bail application be rejected. Perused the record of case and material available on record. From perusal it transpires that the instant case has been filed on the written application of informant namely Rina Kumari. The instant case has been filed against the petitioner and five others under section 85, 115(2), 126(2), 352 of BNS and 3 / 4 of D. P Act. After receiving of the Case record, a notice was issued to the complainant of Case no	

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Cont..... 15.04.2026	100/2025 and Reena Kumari appeared through her lawyer. The parties failed settled their dispute in amicable manner. On perusal of LCR of Case no 100/2025, it transpires that the allegations are omnibus in nature. More over the case is triable by the Magistrate. Apex Court in Arnesh Kumar case, dealing with the issue of “deliberate and rampant misuse of provisions of Section 498-A of IPC as a tool of harassment by a disgruntled wife has pleased issued guide line to court. Petitioner claims clean antecedent on affidavit and nothing adverse has been brought on record during hearing from the side of the prosecution. Considering the above enumerated facts & circumstances and lack of criminal antecedent, the prayer for bail of the petitioners stands allowed. Let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below in the event of arrest or surrender with direction that the petitioners shall cooperate with the trial and make himself available as and when so required and in case of failure, the court shall be at liberty to cancel bail. They are further directed to remain present in the court till framing of charge. Let a copy of this order along with LCR be transmitted to Ld. Court below forthwith.
