24.03.2026	<p>An anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused petitioners namely (1) Rahul Kumar Singh (2) Chandan Kumar @ Chandan Kumar Singh who are apprehending their arrest in connection with <b>Dinara P.S. Case no. 535/2025</b>, registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 61, 109, 351(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS, 2023.</p> <p>Case has been heard and was posted for an order today. Sudhanshu Kumar, Ld. counsel on behalf of accused appeared and submitted that applicant is innocent and have not committed any offence and they have falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that this case is nothing but counterblast of <b>Dawath P.S. Case no. 534/2025</b>. He further submits that the informant has multiple FIR in his name. The petitioners are ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence their application for anticipatory bail be allowed.</p> <p>Ld. APP appearing on behalf of State has opposed the anticipatory bail application. He argued that matter of an application has been registered under section 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 61, 109, 351(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS, 2023. He argued that the petitioner has one criminal antecedent i.e, <b>Dinara P.S. Case no. 349/2024</b>. Hence the instant anticipatory bail application be rejected.</p> <p>Perused the record of case and material available on record. From perusal it transpires that the instant case has been filed on the written application of informant namely Rajkumar Mishra. The instant case has been filed against the petitioners and thirteen others for the offence punishable under sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 61, 109, 351(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS, 2023.</p>

Cont..... 24.03.2026	<p>On perusal of para no. 32, 33, 34, and 35 of the case diary and annexed medical report with the diary, it prima facie reveals that injuries are simple in nature. Para 38 of case diary prima facie reveals that the petitioners have one criminal antecedent. There is admitted land dispute as FIR itself. Other accused persons have been granted benefits of bail vide BP 1/23 and ABP 799/25.</p> <p>Considering the above enumerated facts &amp; circumstances and nature of injuries sustained, the prayer for bail of the petitioners <b>stands allowed.</b></p> <p>Let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below in the event of arrest or surrender with direction that the petitioners shall cooperate with the trial and make himself available as and when so required and in case of failure, the court shall be at liberty to cancel bail.</p> <p>Let a copy of this order be transmitted to Ld. Court below forthwith.
