02.04.2026	<p>Bail application along with power has been filed on behalf of Petitioner Sangeeta Kuer who is in judicial custody since 08.12.2025 in connection with Bikramganj P.S Case No. 821/2025, registered u/s 103(1), 3(5), 61(2) of BNS, 2023 and 27 Arms Act.</p> <p>Case has been heard and was posted for an order today. Mr. Kishor Kumar Kamal, Learned counsel for petitioner have submitted that petitioner is innocent have committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case due to grudge and ulterior motive. He also submits that the only allegation on this petitioner is that she has come at the place of occurrence and stated that her enemy has died. He is ready to abide all the conditions of bail. Hence his application for bail be allowed.</p> <p>Ld. APP appearing on behalf of State has opposed the bail application. He argued that FIR has been registered under sections 103(1), 3(5), 61(2) of BNS, 2023 and 27 Arms Act. and custody of accused person is required for investigation and unfolding the crimes committed by them. He argued that a bail petition of the petitioners have been rejected by the court of A.C.J.M- 1, Bikramganj. Hence the instant bail application be rejected.</p> <p>Heard both the parties and perused the record of case and material available on record. From perusal it transpires that the instant case has been registered on the written application of informant namely Beauty Kumari. The instant case has been filed against the petitioner and ten others for the offence punishable under sections 103(1), 3(5), 61(2) of BNS, 2023 and 27 Arms Act. Prosecution story in nutshell is that under criminal conspiracy with petitioner , other co accused person committed the offence of murder of one Akhilesh Rai in day light at about 3.45pm on 07/12/2025. After the incident of murder , the petitioner sought <i>Dushaman mara</i></p>

gya. The incidence is witnessed by the informant and his son.

On perusal it transpire that informant in her further statement at para 07 of CD and other witnesses at para 08, 46, 47, 48 and 62 of CD have supported the prosecution version of the case. The injuries is over the vital part of the body i,e head and chest of the deceased. The perusal of case dairy prima facie revels that injuries are grievous in nature. As per para no 173 of the Case Diary, the cause of death is hemorrhage and shock due to fire arms injury. The fire arms injury over the head and cheat of the deceased, shows the intentions, which major elements of sec 103 of BNS.

Considering the facts stated above, gravity of offence, head injuries and other antemortem injuries, This court is not inclined to grant bail to this petitioner. Accordingly prayer for **bail stands rejected**.
