	01/07/2023	Record has been put up today for orders after completion of inquiry under section 202 Cr. PC, 1973 and hearing on the point of summoning. This complaint petition has been filed by Sonam Kumari against her husband Oshiar Singh; Bigni Kuer, her mother-in-law; Vikash Singh @Vakil, her brother-in-law; and Kavita Devi, her sister-in-law for the offences punishable under sections 498A, 306, 323 of IPC and u/s 3/4 of DP Act. It has been alleged by the complainant that she was married with Oshair Singh in the year 2016 and since marriage itself all the accused persons have been torturing her for bringing three lakh rupees from her parental home for the purchase of a car. The statement of the complainant was recorded under section 200 CrPC. in which she has supported the allegations levelled by her in the complaint petition. An inquiry was also conducted in the matter u/s 202 CrPC, in which complainant has produced two witnesses who have supported the allegations levelled by the complainant. On perusal of the complaint petition, statement recorded under section 200 CrPC and inquiry conducted U/s 202 CrPC, this court finds that prima facie sufficient materials are there on the record to proceed against the accused persons for the offences punishable under sections 498A and 323 of IPC and section 3/4 of DP Act. Accordingly, office clerk is directed to issue summons against the above-named accused persons Oshiar Singh, Bigni Kuer, Vikash Singh @ Vakil and Kavita Devi for the offences punishable under sections 498A and 323 of IPC and u/s 3/4 of DP act after filing of requisites and process fees by the
