28-02-2020	A surrender cum permission petition along with power of Ld. Advocate on behalf of the accused / petitioners, namely, (1) Mukesh singh and (2) Chhoutu singh have been filed in Akodigola P.S. Case No. 41 / 2017 for the offence punishable u/s 341,323,354 (A)(B) 504,506 of the IPC. Copy of the same has been served to the Ld. A.P.O. Bail petition pressed by learned counsel Sri Krishna Singh of the accused petitioner. Accused persons are taken into custody. Case called out. Ld. Counsel of the applicants submits that petitioners are innocent and have committed no Offence and their bail has been allowed by the Learned District & Sessions Judge, Rohtas at Sasaram vide A.B.P. No. 2426/2019 dated-23-01-2020. That they are ready to abide by the order of the learned Court to be imposed on them. That they are ready to fulfill the condition laid down U/s 438(2) Cr.P.C. Therefore prayed that petitioner may kindly be allow to furnish bail bonds. Ld. A.P.O. does not oppose the bail. Heard both side and perused the record. From perusal of the record it appears that bail has been allowed by the Learned District & Sessions Judge, Rohtas at Sasaram vide A.B.P. No. 2426/2019 dated-23-01-2020 and the accused Petitioners surrender before the court under stipulated time Period. Hence I inclined to permit the petitioners to furnish bail bond. J.M.
