	20.02.2025	This record has been pending before this court due to the non-appearance of the accused, Harish Khurana, who was summoned by this court vide order dated 18th July 2023 for the offence punishable under Section 138 of the N.I. Act, 1881. As per the information downloaded from the website of the Indian Postal Department, the summons sent to him was received by him way back on 29.09.2023. However, he has still not appeared before the court. Thereafter, a bailable warrant was issued, and even then, his appearance could not be ensured before the court. Consequently, this court had to issue a Non-Bailable Warrant (NBW) against him, which was sent to the Superintendent of Police, Panipat, vide Dispatch Book Number 529 dated 16th April 2024. However, the accused has not appeared before the court. In light of the aforesaid facts, this court deems it fit to cancel the previously issued NBW and issue a fresh NBW against the said accused. The Office Clerk is directed to send a copy of the summoning order dated 18th July 2024, passed against the accused Harish Khurana, along with a copy of this order and the fresh NBW, through registered post to the SP, Panipat. The Office Clerk is further directed to send the said documents via email to the SP, Panipat, who is requested to execute the NBW against the accused, Harish Khurana, to ensure that further proceedings in the case are not delayed due to his non-appearance before the court.
