	27.09.2024	Record has been put up today for orders after hearing on the point of summoning the accused persons. This complaint petition has been filed by Meera Devi against Bunty Kumar and Ravi Kumar. for the offences punishable under sections 323, 341, 354, 504 and 506/34 of IPC. It has been alleged by the complainant that on August 25, 2022, at 3 p.m., she had gone to Babuganj to purchase paneer from the shop of the accused persons. She has further alleged that when accused no. 2, Ravi Kumar, gave her the paneer, she found insects in it. When she brought this to the notice of the accused, they became very angry and began abusing her. She also alleged that when she objected to the abusive language, the accused persons grabbed her by the hair, touched her inappropriately, and threatened her, warning that she would face dire consequences if she came again to their area. The statement of the complainant was recorded under section 200 CrPC, in which she has supported the allegations levelled by her in the complaint petition. An inquiry was also conducted in the matter u/s 202 CrPC in which complainant has examined two witnesses on her behalf who have supported the contentions of the complainant. Heard the L.d. counsel of the complainant on the point of summoning the accused persons. On hearing the L.d. counsel of the complainant and after perusal of Complaint petition, SA of the complainant, this court finds that prima facie sufficient materials are on record to proceed against both the accused persons named above for the offences punishable under sections 323, 341, 354, 504 and 506/34 of IPC. Accordingly, office clerk is directed to issue summons against	

the above-named accused persons Bunty Kumar and Ravi Kumar, for the offences punishable under sections 323, 341, 354, 504 and 506/34 of IPC, after filing of requisites and process fees by the complainant. The complainant is directed to file requisites, including the list of prosecution witnesses and process fees, if any, necessary for issuance of summons within 14 days from the date of this order.
