	05/01/2023	Record has been put up today for orders after completion of inquiry under section 202 Cr. PC, 1973 and hearing on the point of summoning. This complaint petition has been filed by Ravishanker Bidharthi against Jitendra Kumar for the offences punishable under sections 406 & 420 of IPC and under section 138 of NI Act. It has been alleged by the complainant that the accused person was his partner in his business. Later, both of them dissolved the firm and in order to settle the accounts, the accused person had given him eight cheques. It has further been alleged by the complainant that when he presented one of the cheques bearing no. 167679 of Rs. Two Lakh on 03.03.2017, then the same got dishonored. Then, two other cheques of Rs. 4 lakh and 2.5 lakh got dishonoured as they failed in UV lamp test. Thereafter, a legal notice was given to the accused person regarding dishonor of the cheque but the accused person has neither replied to the said notice nor paid the cheque amount. The statement of the complainant was recorded under section 200 CrPC. in which he has supported the allegations levelled by him in the complaint petition. An inquiry was also conducted in the matter u/s 202 CrPC in which complainant has examined two witnesses on his behalf who have supported the contentions of the complainant. complainant has also placed on record photo stat copies of cheques issued by accused, legal notice sent to the accused, etc. Heard the Ld. counsel of the complainant on the point of summoning the accused person.
