	10.03.2026	Record has been put up today for orders after hearing on the point of summoning the accused persons. This petition has been filed by Radhiak Devi against the accused persons namely Krishna Singh, Mirtunjay Singh, Deepak Kumar, Saloni Kumari and Sandhya Devi, for the offences punishable under sections 316(2), 115(2), 127 (2), 84, 352 and 351(2) of BNS, 2023. The case of the informant, as alleged in the complaint petition, is that she was married to Krishna Singh in the year 2002. It has further been stated by her that after the marriage, the behaviour of the members of her matrimonial family was not cordial and, on account of her dark complexion, they started demanding dowry from her and told her that if she did not bring money from her parental home, she would not be allowed to stay in the matrimonial home. It has further been alleged by her that a son, namely Ankit Kumar, was born out of the said wedlock, and that on 28th September 2020, the accused persons finally ousted the complainant and her son from the matrimonial home for failure to fulfil the demand of dowry made by her husband and his family members. The statement of the complainant was recorded under section 223 BNSS, in which she has supported the allegations levelled by her in the complaint petition. An inquiry was also conducted in the matter u/s 225 BNSS in which the complainant has examined two witnesses on her behalf who have supported the contentions of the complainant. After an inquiry was conducted in the matter, a notice under Section 223 of the BNSS was issued to the accused person to make submissions with regard to the allegations levelled against them but they have chosen not to appear before the court. On hearing the Ld. counsel of the complainant and after perusal of Complaint petition, SA of the complainant and inquiry conducted in the matter, this court finds that prima facie sufficient materials are on record to proceed against the accused person namely Krishna Singh for the offences punishable u/ss 85 & 115(2) of BNS, 2023.	

Further, this Court finds that no prima facie material is available on record against the accused persons other than Krishna Singh. The complainant, in her statement recorded under Section 223 of the BNSS, has not made any specific allegation against the other accused persons and the allegations against them appear to be general and omnibus in nature. In the absence of any specific material disclosing the ingredients of the alleged offences against them, no prima facie case is made out against the said accused persons. Accordingly, the proceedings against the accused persons, except Krishna Singh, are hereby dropped.

Accordingly, office clerk is directed to issue summons against the accused person Krishna Singh, for the offences punishable under sections 85 & 115(2) of BNS, 2023, after filing of requisites and process fees by the complainant. The complainant is directed to file requisites, including the list of prosecution witnesses and process fees, if any, necessary for issuance of summons within 14 days from the date of this order.
