	18/08/2023	Record has been put up today for orders after completion of inquiry under section 202 Cr. PC, 1973 and hearing on the point of summoning. This complaint petition has been filed by Ramesh Kumar against Sweta Mishra, the then DCLR, Dehri and four other constables who were with her at the time of incident for the offences punishable under sections 166, 323, 352, 500/34 of IPC. It has been alleged by the complainant that on 20/04/2020 at about 10 AM in the morning, he had gone to Dr. Ajay Kumar, Dehri for treatment of his piles. It has further been submitted by him that when he was returning after consultation with the doctor, then accused Sweta Mishra directed the constables with her to beat the complainant for violating prohibitions during the lock-down, which was in force at that point of time due to covid pandemic outbreak. It has further been submitted by him that in spite of prescription of doctor produced by him, all the accused persons beat him severely and abused him. The statement of the complainant was recorded under section 200 CrPC. in which he has supported the allegations levelled by him in the complaint petition. An inquiry was also conducted in the matter u/s 202 CrPC in which he has produced two witnesses who have also supported the allegations levelled by him. Before proceeding further, it is pertinent to state that, in order to ascertain the name of the constables who were with the accused Sweta Mishra at the time of incident; SP, Rohtas was requested to provide the details of the bodyguards deputed with her at that point of time.
