22-10-2019	A bail petition which is filed on dated 16-10-2019 has been moved today for hearing on the point of bail on behalf of custody accused namely, Triloki Singh in Akorhigola P.S.Case No. 209 / 2019 for the offence punishable u/s 341, 323, 307, 504, 506, 34 of the IPC. Copy of the same has already been served to the Ld. A.P.O. Bail petition pressed by learned counsel Sri Krishna Singh of the accused petitioner. Accused person is in custody since 11-10-2019. Learned counsel has submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offences. That no any bail application either regular or anticipatory bail has been filed eariler before any court. He has further submitted that he has been falsely implicated in this case and occurance did not take place in the manner alleged. He has further submitted that there is in ordinate delay in lodging the FIR. That both the parties are Gotiya and there are land dispute in between the parties. That alleged offences areailable except 307 IPC which is not applicable against the petitioner. That there are general and vague allegation no specific. That petitioner wife Laxmina Devi filed a complaint against the informant of this case which is Complain Case No. 356 / 2019. Accordingly he has prayed to enlarge the petitioners on bail. The Ld. A.P.O. vehemently opposed prayer of bail. After hearing both the sides I have perused the record and on perusal of same I find that at the time of hearing on bail of the accused-petitioner, this court called for the updated case diary and injury report from the concerned P.S.. From perusal of the case diary it appears that all the witness stated that there is land dispute between the parties. All the injuries are simple in nature. Regard being had to the facts and circumstances and the period of incarceration undergone by the accused-petitioner, the accused-petitioner Triloki Singh is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount eacj subject to the condition that one of the bailor should be close relative of the accused-petitioner.
