Parsuram Singh has been filed in Dehri P.S. Case No. 718/2019 for the offence punishable u/s 143,341,323,379,337,504 of the IPC. Copy of the same has been served to the Ld. A.P.O. Accused persons are taken into custody. Case called out. Ld. Counsel of the applicants submit that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. That earlier no such bail application either anticipatory or regular has been filed before any Court. That informant has lodged this false case with new to cover out neglitation from the case filed by accused case No. 717/2019 . Ld. Counsel for applicants further submitted that all alleged sections are bailable except 379 of the IPC, which is super addition, it is therefore prayed that petitioners may kindly be allowed to furnish bail bonds. Ld. A.P.O. opposes the bail. Heard both sides and perused the record. From perusal of the record it appears that All sections levelled against the petitioners are bailable in nature except 379 of the IPC, which is super addition, Hence I am inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 6000/- with two solvent sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court.
