29-08-2019	A surrender cum Bail petition along with power of Learned Counsel has been filed on behalf of accused petitioner, namely, Birju Kumar @ Briju Kumar in Dehri (Town) P.S.Case No. 1055 / 2018 for the offence punishable u/s 135 of the Electricity Act. Copy of the same has been served to the Ld. A.P.O. Bail petition pressed by learned counsel Sri Ritesh Kumar of the accused petitioner. Accused person is taken into custody. Learned counsel has submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely implicated in this case by informant. That no any bail application either regular or anticipatory bail has been filed eariler before any court. He has further submitted that prosecution case is false, fabricated and concocted. He has further submitted that petitioner has not made any theft of electricity power. He has further submitted that petitioner is bonafide customer of South Bihar Power Distribution Company Pvt. Ltd. And he has deposited to so called fine Rs 41332.00 in related office. The section labelled isailable. Accordingly he has prayed to enlarge the petitioners on bail. The Ld. A.P.O. vehemently opposed prayer of bail After hearing both the sides I have perused the record and on perusal of same I find that the a case registered on the basis of a written complaint given by informant, Loknath Prasad, Jr. Engineer. As per written report of the informant, the prosecution case in breif is that on 24-11-2018, the the team from electricity dept. raided the premises of the accused person and found them illegally tapping electricity, from L.T.I. and imposed fine of rs. 41332.00. Copy of money deposition receipt of rs. 41332.00 in south bihar power distribution company pvt. Ltd. And copy of certificate of no balace due issued by asstt. Electrical engineer has also been submitted and an affidavit stating therin that petitiner has no dues as a fine in electricity department. From perusal of the same, it is found that accused-petitioner has pay Rs 41332.00 as a fine to the Electricity Department. Accused person voluntarily surrender before the court and this is the first appearance of the accused person. Hence I inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs-6000/- with one sureties of the like amount each. J.M. Dehri-On-Sone.
