	04.04.2024	Record has been put up today for orders after hearing on the point of summoning the accused person. This complaint petition has been filed by Geeta Bhattacharya against Ansuiya Pandey, Raju Pandey, Barun Pandey, Rinki Devi, Pinki Devi, Priti Devi and Madhumangal Dubey for the offences punishable under sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 448, 452, 380, 384, 386, 427, 504 & 506/34 of IPC. It has been alleged by the complainant that the accused no. 1 ansuiya Pandey worked as maid in the house of his brother-in-law. Since, the accused no. 1 did not have good relations with her husband, therefore, his brother-in-law Bhavdev Bhattacharya had given her one room on monthly rent of Rs. 200. In the year 2020, Bhavdev Bhattacharya died issueless, therefore, his properties devolved upon her husband Barun Deo, one of the heirs of deceased Bhavdev Bhattacharya. It has further been alleged by her that when she asked the accused no. 1 to vacate her house then she and other accused persons abused her and also beat her and took away a number of belongings of her deceased brother-in-law, whose ownership now lies with her family members. The statement of the complainant was recorded under section 200 CrPC. in which she has supported the allegations levelled by her in the complaint petition. An inquiry was also conducted in the matter u/s 202 CrPC in which complainant has examined two witnesses on her behalf who have supported the contentions of the complainant. Heard the Ld. counsel of the complainant on the point of summoning the accused person. On hearing the Ld. counsel of the complainant and after perusal	

of Complaint petition, SA of the complainant and documentary evidence available on the case record, this court is of the view that prima facie there are sufficient materials on record for the offences punishable under sections 323, 379 and 504 of IPC against the accused persons namely Ansuiya Pandey, Raju Paney and Barun Pandey only.

Accordingly, office clerk is directed to issue summons against the above-named accused persons Ansuiya Pandey, Raju Paney and Barun Pandey, for the offences punishable under sections 323, 379 and 504 of IPC after filing of requisites and process fees by the complainant. The complainant is directed to file requisites, including the list of prosecution witnesses and process fees, if any, necessary for issuance of summons within 14 days from the date of this order.
