1. Anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of petitioner namely **1. Chandra Shekhar**, who apprehends his arrest in connection with Complaint **Case No. 432C/2023** registered under sections 406, 420 of IPC and 138 Negotiable Instrument Act.

2. That vide order dated 20.01.2026, the accused/petitioner was granted interim protection by this court, but after then the accused/petitioner stopped appearing in this matter on date of hearing i.e 03.02.2026 and 27.02.2026 and even today no one has appeared.

3. It is also important to mention here that vide order dated 20.01.2026, this court had ordered to deposit 20% of the total cheque amount as per Negotiable Instrument Act, but the accused/petitioner has neither paid the amount nor appearing in this matter, which shows the ulterior motive of the petitioner, therefore the present anticipatory bail **is dismissed** for non appearance as well as non compliance of order of this court.

Accordingly the present bail petition is disposed off.
