1. The present revision petition has been filed by revisionist/complainant namely Ramesh Sharma @ Ramesh Kumar Sharma to assail the **impugned order dated 30.01.2021** passed by Sri Ravi Kumar Ld. JM 1st class, Saharsa in **Complaint case no. 1201C/2019**, by which Ld. Trial court has dismissed the instant complaint.

2. Being aggrieved by the order of Ld. JM 1st Class, the complainant has preferred this revision petition on the ground that the court below has misunderstood the complaint and the present impugned order is illegal.

3. Heard Ld. Counsel for the revisionist and Ld. APP for the state.

4. Ld. Counsel for the revisionist namely Krishna Kumar submits that order may be passed on the grounds mentioned in the revision.

5. Perused the record, Impugned Order, S.A. of the complainant namely Ramesh Sharma, evidence of Enquiry Witness No. 1 Shail Vardhan, Enquiry Witness No. 2 Bechan Sharma and Enquiry Witness No. 3 Raghu Sah along with complaint petition.

6. On perusal of record, this court finds that there is no illegality, impropriety or incorrectness in the impugned order, therefore the present revision petition is **dismissed**.

7. Let the Trial Court Record be sent back to concern court and file of present revision petition be consigned to record room.
