1. The present criminal miscellaneous has been filed by Juhi Praween i.e. wife, for cancellation of bail granted to her husband Md. Tarik Imam i.e. opposite party on the ground that husband is not fulfilling the condition of the bail order passed by Ld. ADJ-IV, Saharsa in A.B.A. No. 76/2025, arising out of Complaint Case No. 440C/2024.

2. In the present petition, petitioner wife has further stated that the Ld. Trial court i.e. Ld. JM 1st Class, Saharsa, Sri. Nikhil Chandra has not applied his judicial mind and has confirmed the bail of the husband, provisionally granted by Ld. ADJ IV in A.B.A. No. 76/2025 and further ground of the wife is that the husband is not taking her to the matrimonial house .

3. Opposite party/husband Md. Tarik Imam has **filed an affidavit** dated 22.05.2026 with advance copy supplied to the counsel for the petitioner wife, but till today no reply to the said affidavit has been filed by the petitioner wife.

4. Opposite Party/husband has mentioned the detail circumstances in the affidavit that how his wife is not residing with him despite several efforts made by him and when he took his wife to the matrimonial house then one fine day i.e. 02.06.2025, at about 4:00 AM, she run away from the matrimonial house with several articles and money.

5. It is well established principle of law that **once a bail is always a bail** unless there is a serious violation of the conditions of the bail.

In the present case the petitioner wife has not been able to establish the strong ground for cancellation of bail granted to the husband and has chosen not to file the reply to the affidavit filed by the husband, therefore the present Criminal Miscellaneous for cancellation of bail is **dismissed.**
