1. Anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of petitioner namely **1. Shyam Sunder Sah**, who apprehends his arrest in connection with **Saharsa Sadar P.S Case No. 486/2024** registered under sections 147, 149, 341, 323, 307, 354, 504, 506 and 304 of IPC.

2. The allegation as per FIR and informant Arhul Devi is that on 19.05.2024 at about 8:00 PM the accused/petitioner Shyam Sunder Sah along with other accused persons entered into the house of the informant lashed with farsa, pistol and rod etc. and started abusing & assaulting and inflicted injury upon the informant side.

3. Heard Ld. counsel for the petitioner and Ld. APP for the State.

4. This is the **second anticipatory bail petition** by the accused/petitioner, whose earlier ABA No. 478/2024, was rejected vide order dated 03.09.2024 by Ld. Predecessor of this court and no new ground has been mentioned in the present bail petition.

5. Ld. APP vehemently opposes the bail stating that one of the **injured Binod Kumar Sah has died** during treatment. He further submits that ABA of Pankaj Sah and Sagar Sah @ Sagar Kumar was rejected by this court vide its order dated 08.10.2025 and therefore parity and consistency should be maintained in the order of this court.

6. Considering the **death of one of the injured** namely Binod Kumar Sah **AND** no new ground in this second anticipatory bail application **AND** the fact that anticipatory bail of other 2 co-accused namely Pankaj Sah and Sagar

Sah @ Sagar Kumar has been rejected by this court, the prayer of present accused petitioner namely Shyam Sunder Sah @ Bauka does not inspire the indulgence of this court and therefore this court **is not inclined** to grant anticipatory bail to the accused/petitioner, hence the present bail petition is hereby **rejected**.

Accordingly the present bail petition is disposed off.
