1. Bail application has been filed on behalf of petitioners namely **1. Pappu Kumar 2. Pappu Kumar @ Manish 3. Dilkhush Kumar and 4. Ravindra Yadav, who is in custody since 23.01.2026,** in connection with Bangaon P.S Case No. 07/2026 registered under sections 318(4), 112(2), 61(2), of BNS and 10(1), 11(1) of Bihar Public Examination Act.

2. The prosecution story in brief is that the present FIR has been lodged on written complaint of Police Sub Inspector Suryadev Yadav in which it has been alleged that on 20.01.2026, when the police force was on patrolling then at about 10:45 PM near Shivji Mandir near Rahuyamani canal at Bariyahi Bazar, total 6 persons were apprehended from a Scorpio including all 4 accused/petitioners, who later on confessed and revealed that they are examinee of Sub Inspector Examination, and had come on call of Ramanand Thakur @ Daulat, who had taken their all original education certificates and mobile, and assured that he will leak the question paper and provide them and all the accused/petitioners will have to pay Rs. 20 lakhs, to the main accused Ramanand Thakur @ Daulat.

3. Heard, Ld. Counsel for the petitioners and Ld. APP for the state.

4. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submit that accused/petitioners are not the crime doer, rather they are the victim of alleged crime. He further submits that no incriminating material has been recovered from all the petitioners, who were apprehended and arrested from the spot.

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5. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submit that all the accused/petitioners are **young students**, who are preparing for various competitive examination. He further submits that accused/petitioner no. 2 Pappu Kumar @ Manish has to appear in the examination of Assistant Educational Development Officer, conducted by BPSC on 17.04.2026 and accused/petitioner no.4 Ravindra Yadav has to appear in the same examination on 14.04.2026 and has filed a admit card in this regard.

6. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the accused/petitioner no.3 Dilkhush Kumar is also appearing in the same examination and has filed an affidavit of his father Sri. Sitaram Yadav.

7. Counsel for the petitioner further makes a statement at Bar for remaining one accused i.e petitioner no.1 Pappu Kumar, that he is also appearing in the same examination, but he could not obtain any admit card or affidavit in this regard as nobody from his family could be contacted.

8. Perused the record and case diary. On perusal of record it transpires that in the present matter **charge-sheet has been filled** against all the accused/petitioners and investigation with regard to these petitioners has been completed.

9. On query, Ld. APP submits that only material against the accused/petitioners is that they have been in contact with main accused/master mind Ramanand Thakur @ Daulat on mobile phone as per para 30 and 48 of case diary and he further submits that one unclaimed mobile has been recovered, which appears to belong to accused Ravindra Yadav. Apart from this, there is no other material in

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the entire case diary.

10. Considering the **clean antecedent** of all the accused/petitioners **AND** the fact that **charge-sheet has been filed** and investigation against all these accused/petitioners are completed **AND** apart from that petitioners were in touch with main accused, no incriminating material has been either recovered or discovered with regard to these accused/petitioners **AND** considering the **future of these young** accused/petitioner, who are student and has to appear in up coming examination of Assistant Education Development Officer, the prayer for regular bail of all these accused/petitioners namely 1. Pappu Kumar 2. Pappu Kumar @ Manish 3. Dilkhush Kumar and 4. Ravindra Yadav is **allowed** and **they are directed to be released on bail** on furnishing of bail bond of Rs. 10000/- each with two sureties of like amount.

11. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that all the accused/petitioners is willing and would be loving to do some social work and community service for the society. Since they are student they each would like to give free tuition to 10 children of BPL category of his village. Therefore they each are asked to give free tuition to 10 children up to class 8 of BPL category for 3 hours daily, 5 days in a week **for next 6 months** and after completion of every month, they will obtain a certificate from the parents of all the children till six months and also obtain a certificate from **Mukhiya** or **Sarpanch** or **Ward Counselor** of their area in this regard and file the same in the court concern.

Accordingly the present bail petition is disposed off.
