16.04.2026	Both the anticipatory bail applications have arisen out of Banma Itahari P. S. Case No. 14/2026, therefore these regular bail applications have taken up together for hearing and are being disposed of by this common order. 2. This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioners namely (1) Rajdeep Yadav S/o Kailu Yadav, (2) Angad Yadav S/o Kailu Yadav, (3) Shuben Yadav S/o Anup Yadav, (4) Brahmdeo Yadav S/o Anup Yadav, (5) Chandradeo Yadav S/o	

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Kamleshwari Yadav, (6) **Chandra Kishor Yadav** S/o Late Bindeshwari Yadav, (7) **Ranvir Kumar** S/o Bhola Yadav and (8) **Mukesh Yadav** S/o Bharat Yadav who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Banma Itahari P.S. Case No. 14/2026 registered under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 126(2), 109, 127 (2), 3(5), 352, 351(2) (3) of BNS, 2023.

2. Heard the arguments of the learned counsel for the petitioners of both the bail applications and the learned P.P. for the State.

3. It is submitted by the learned counsels for the accused petitioners of both the bail applications that petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case due to grudge, malice and dirty village party politics. It is further submitted that the petitioners bears no criminal antecedent except petitioner Ranvir Kumar who bears criminal antecedent of one case i.e. Banma Itahari P.S. Case No. 76/2024. It is further submitted that petitioners have no manner of concern with the alleged incident. It is further submitted that Sections 109, 118(1) of BNS, 2023 are added to make the case graver and non-bailable. It is further submitted that there exists land dispute between the parties and there is case and counter case between them. It is further submitted that petitioners are men of means and there is no chance of their absconding in this case and they are ready to furnish sound sureties to the full satisfaction of the learned court. Upon these grounds, the learned counsel prays to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

4. On the other hand, the learned P.P. for the state vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioners of both the bail applications.

5. Rival submissions considered, Record perused.

6. The prosecution case as per *Fardbeyan* of the informant, Rajendra Yadav is that on 20.01.2026 at about 12:30 O'clock he was cultivating his private and

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khatiyani land whose Khata No. 931, Khesra No. 3708, 3709 and 3711 under Ghordaur when the accused persons namely Chanardev Yadav, Ranvir Yadav, Ranjeet Yadav, Chandra Kishor yadav, Rajendra Yadav, Sadanand Yadav, Roshan Yadav, Rajdeep Yadav, Angad Yadav, Nawin Yadav, Shuben Yadav, Brahmdeo Yadav, Suresh Yadav, Mukesh Yadav and Birbal Yadav armed with lathi and danda and caught him and assaulted him. When his grandson Sarvan Kumar and Partosh came to rescue him then the accused persons assaulted them due to which they sustained injury on their head and they fell down on the ground. The injured persons were referred to Sadar Hospital, Saharsa for treatment.

7. There is case and counter case between the parties. The injury suffered by the injured persons are simple in nature and most of the injuries are on non vital part of the body of the injured persons. The petitioners bears no criminal antecedent except petitioner Ranvir Kumar who bears criminal antecedent of one case i.e. Banma Itahari P.S. Case No. 76/2024 as mentioned in para 3 of the bail application whereas as per para 82 of the case diary petitioner Rajdeep Yadav, Angad Yadav, Shuben Yadav and Brahmdeo Yadav and Chandradeo Yadav bears no criminal antecedent whereas as per para 83, 84 and 85 of the case diary petitioners Chandra Kishor Yadav, Ranvir Kumar and Mukesh Yadav bears criminal antecedent of one case.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the prayer for anticipatory bail of petitioners of both the bail applications namely (1) **Rajdeep Yadav**, (2) **Angad Yadav**, (3) **Shuben Yadav**, (4) **Brahmdeo Yadav**, (5) **Chandradeo Yadav**, (6) **Chandra Kishor Yadav**, (7) **Ranvir Kumar** and (8) **Mukesh Yadav** are **allowed** and in the event of arrest or surrender of the petitioners within a period of four weeks from today, they are directed to be released on bail subject to their furnishing bail bonds in the sum of

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Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned jurisdictional Magistrate where the case is presently pending, further subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of BNSS.
