	21.04.2026	<p>This bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely Bablu Yadav S/o Kamal Yadav is in custody since 05.01.2026 in connection with Darhar P.S. Case No. 44/2025 registered under Sections 191(2), 191(3), 126(2), 115(2), 109, 103(1), 118(1) and 352 of BNS, 2023.</p> <p>2. Heard the arguments of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P. for the State.</p> <p>3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the accused petitioner that petitioner is in custody since 05.01.2026. It is further submitted that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence and he has falsely been implicated in this case due to grudge, malice and dirty village party politics. It is further submitted that petitioner is a man of means and he is ready to furnish sound sureties to the full satisfaction of the court. Upon these grounds, the learned counsel prays to grant bail to the petitioner.</p> <p>4. On the other hand, the learned P.P. for the State.</p> <p>5. Sanjay Yadav, Rajesh Yadav, Rahul Yadav, Jyotish Yadav, Dev Kumar Yadav, Sansvid Yadav, Ghuran Yadav, Umesh Yadav, Anil Yadav all resident of Naula, Ward No. 3 and 4 P.S. Darhar, District Saharsa with 15-20 unknown persons plough the field and his brother Santosh Yadav objected then all the accused persons assaulted him. Mayalal Yadav and Nilambar Yadav ordered to kill him on which Bablu Yadav and Sudhir Yadav armed with farsa and khanti in their hands assaulted on the head of the brother of informant due to which he sustained injury on his head and he fell down. All the accused persons assaulted him due to which he became badly injured. When his father came to rescue his brother then Rajkumar Yadav and Umesh Yadav also assaulted him with Khanti due to which his father sustained injury on his head. All the accused persons have assaulted all his family members. On hearing hulla of nearby people all the accused persons fled away from there. With the help of villagers all the injureds were brought to Sadar Hospital, Saharsa for treatment where his brother Santosh Yadav was referred to Siliguri (Bengal) where he died during the treatment. Hence the case registered.

7. There are specific allegation against this petitioner that he along with co-accused Sudhir Yadav gave farsa and khanti blow on the head of the deceased. As per post-mortem report the following injuries were found on the person of the deceased :-
(1) Surgically repaired wound 2" long present over midline at anterior sagital suture to upward towards Lt parietal eminence apposed with 4" stitches with black silk. (2) O/D scalp & percraneal hematoma present over Lt. Fronto-parieto-ocipital area. (3) Linear fracture 6" in length present over Lt. Temporal & parietal region. (4) Extra Dural hemorrhage, sub dural hemorrhage & laceration 2"x 2" area of the cerebral cortex at corresponding area. (5) Surgically repaired wound measuring 2" long present over back of Rt. Ear 3" in length repaired with 7 stitches up to the margin to the Lt. ear 3"x4" area hematoma present at

underlying soft tissue. (7) surgically repaired wound 2” in length apposed with 4 stitches at between the wave of Lt little finger & ring finger. (8) Surgically repaired wound measuring ½” long present over Lt mid shin bone. (9) There is contusion present over the Rt. Temporal lobe along with cerebral hematoma present at Rt. Parietal area also.

8. This accused cannot claim parity with the other co-accused persons who have been granted anticipatory bail as there are direct and specific allegation against the petitioner for causing injuries to the deceased.

9. The allegations are serious and supported by medical evidence. Murder is one of the most heinous offence of BNS. If the petitioner is released on bail, at this stage it is highly likely that the petitioner would try to influence the witnesses. The possibility of fleeing from justice cannot be ruled out.

10. In view of the above no case is made out to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage. Resultantly, the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner **Bablu Yadav** is hereby **rejected**.
