30.03.2026	This bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely Itihash Kumar Mandal S/o Vinod Kumar Mandal @ Vinod Mandal who is in custody since 08.01.2026 in connection with Darhar P.S. Case No. 3/2026 registered under Sections 25(1-B)a, 26 of the Arms Act. 2. Heard the arguments of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P. for the State. 3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the accused petitioner that petitioner is in custody since 08.01.2026. It is further submitted that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence and he has falsely been implicated in this case. It is further submitted that nothing has been recovered from the physical and conscious possession of the petitioner. It is further submitted that petitioner is a man of means and he is ready to furnish sound sureties to the full satisfaction of the court. Upon these grounds, the learned counsel prays to grant bail to the petitioner. 4. On the other hand, the learned P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of bail. 5. Rival submissions considered, Record perused. 6. The prosecution case, in short as per the typed

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report of informant PSI Rakesh Kumar Singh is that he was on patrolling in his ilaka in his team. He received information that a video of Itihash Kumar brandishing a weapon has gone viral. Raid was conducted at the house and a countrymade pistol was recovered from his house. Accordingly the FIR was registered.

7. The petitioner is in custody since 08.01.2026. The petitioner bears no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 38 of the case diary. Charge-sheet has been submitted in this case. The alleged recovery is from the house of petitioner wherein other family members are also residing.

8. Considering the totality of the facts and circumstances a case to grant bail to the petitioner accused namely Itihash Kumar Mandal is made out. Resultantly the prayer for bail is **allowed**. The petitioners be released on bail subject to their furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate where the case is presently pending further subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 480(3) of the BNSS.
