06.04.2026	This bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely Ajeet Kumar Sharma @ Ajit Kumar Sharma S/o Sikandar Mistri @ Sikendra Sharma who is in custody since 06.02.2026 in connection with Basnahi P.S. Case No. 21/2026 registered under Sections 25(1-B)a, 26 of the Arms Act. 2. Heard the arguments of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P. for the State. 3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the accused petitioner that petitioner is in custody since 06.02.2026. It is further submitted that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence and he has falsely been implicated in this case. It is further submitted that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. It is further submitted that petitioner is a farmer and man of means and there is no chance of his absconding or tampering with the evidence and he is ready to furnish sound sureties to the full satisfaction of the court. Upon these grounds, the learned counsel prays to grant bail to the petitioner. 4. On the other hand, the learned P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of bail. 5. Rival submissions considered, Record perused. 6. The prosecution case, in short as per the typed report of informant PSI Bablu Kumar is that he was on patrolling duty alongwith his team. When he reached at Atalkha Chowk then the Officer-in-charge received through whats app a photo which was viral on facebook and Ajit Bhai Sharma was written and he was holding a weapon in his hand which he was identified by Mahal Chowkidar and it

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was found that the person namely Ajit Kumar Sharma in the photo was holding a weapon in his hand. To verify and necessary action he proceeded to Atalkha near the house of Ajit Kumar Sharma a person came out and on query he disclosed his name as Ajit Kumar Sharma. He disclosed about the weapon in his hand in the viral photo then he told that weapon is him. During search a silver coloured countrymade pistol with a butt length of approx 6 inches, and a body length of about 3 inches and a barrel length of approx 6 inches was recovered from the balcony of his room. On opening the magazine 6 live cartridges were found mentioning 7.65 KF on the bottom. On query about the document regarding recovered pistol he did not replied satisfactory. Search and seizure list was prepared in which both the witnesses put their signatures and a copy of which was handed over to the accused.

7. The petitioner is in custody since 06.02.2026 with clean past antecedent as mentioned in para 39 of the case diary. The investigation is almost complete.

8. Considering the totality of the facts and circumstances a case to grant bail to the petitioner accused namely Ajeet Kumar Sharma @ Ajit Kumar Sharma is made out. Resultantly the prayer for bail is **allowed**. The petitioners be released on bail subject to their furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate where the case is presently pending further subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 480(3) of the BNSS.
