30.03.2026	This bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely Paras Yadav @ Paras Kumar son of Lakshman Yadav who is in custody since 08.12.2025 in connection with Salkhua P.S. Case No. 73/2025 registered under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 74, 103(1) 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS. 2. Heard the arguments of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P. for the State. 3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the accused petitioner that petitioner is in custody since 08.12.2025. It is further submitted that petitioner is innocent and has falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that petitioner bears criminal antecedent of one case i.e. Salkhua P.S. Case No. 81/2025 and the same was disposed off. It is further submitted that Sections 74, 103(1) of BNS, 2023 is not applicable against the petitioner. It is further submitted that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner. Further contended that there exists land dispute between the parties and both parties are gotiyas. It is further submitted that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. It is further submitted that co-accused Lakshman Yadav has been granted bail by this court in R.B.A. No. 966/2025 vide order dated 19.01.2026 and the case of petitioner stands on same and similar footing. It is further submitted that the	

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petitioner is ready to furnish sound sureties to the full satisfaction of the court. Upon these grounds, the learned counsel prays to grant bail to the petitioner.

4. On the other hand, the learned P.P. has opposed the prayer of bail.

5. Rival submissions considered, Record perused.

6. The prosecution case, in brief, as per fardbeyan of informant (Sunita Devi) is that on 12.05.2025 at about 6 o'clock in the morning, she was making the clearance of dam near her house in the meantime, accused person namely 1. Pinki Devi came there and objected to clean the dam. Her father-in-law namely Laturan Yadav also present there. In the said course accused Pinki Devi started to abuse her then informant's husband Shyam Yadav (deceased) and her son Amit Kumar came there and tried to pacify the matter but the accused Pinki Devi continuously abusing them. In the said course, family of Pinki Devi, namely 2. Shatrudhan Yadav 3. Laxman Yadav 4. Ramdas Yadav 5. Sudarshan Yadav 6. Paras Yadav 7. Rubi Kumari 8. Rambha Devi 9. Pampam Devi armed with lathi, Danda and iron rod came there and suddenly attacked on them, in which Sudarshan Yadav assaulted on the head of informant's husband with iron rod and accused persons namely Shatrudhan, Laxman, Ramdas, Paras assaulted informant's husband with stick and iron rod due to which her (informant) husband badly injured and fell on the ground. When her father-in-law and son came to save her husband said accused persons also assaulted them. In the said course, accused Pinky Devi, Rubi Devi, Rambha Devi, Pampam Devi all surrounded the informant and assaulted her. After that they fled away from there and threatened of dire consequences. With the help of villagers, injured were treated at PHC Salkhua but informant's husband has been referred to Sadar Hospital and there the doctor advised her to go to Patna. Therefore, informant admitted her husband to Private Madhav Hospital and during treatment her husband died. Hence the case registered.



7. The petitioner is named in the FIR. The petitioner

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is in custody since 08.12.2025. The petitioner bears criminal antecedent of one case i.e. Salkhua P.S. Case No. 81/2025 and the same was disposed off as mentioned in his bail application.

8. Similarly placed co-accused Laxman Yadav has already been granted bail by the learned Predecessor vide order dated 19.01.2026 passed in R.B.A. No. 966/2025. Upon inquiry the learned P.P. for the State replied that the State had not challenged the aforesaid order before the Hon'ble High court.

9. It is trite law that similarly placed accused person should be treated similarly since the role attributed to the petitioner Paras Yadav @ Paras Kumar is also similar to the co-accused Lakshman Yadav. Therefore, on the ground of parity, the petitioner is also entitled for bail.

10. Considering the totality of the facts and circumstances a case to grant bail to the petitioner is made out. Resultantly the prayer for bail is **allowed**. The petitioner Paras Yadav @ Paras Kumar be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties in the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate where the case is presently pending further subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 480(3) of the BNSS.
