1. Anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of petitioners namely **1. Raj Raushan Kumar @ Laltu 2. Parwati Devi @ Savitri Devi 3. Sanjay Yadav 4. Prabhat Yadav @ Prabhat Ranjan 5. Renu Devi 6. Lalita Devi 7. Gulshan Kumar and 8. Kiran Devi**, who apprehend their arrest in connection with Simri Bakhtiyarpur **P.S Case No. 240/2025** registered under sections 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 109, 352, 351(2) and 3(5) of BNS.

2. The prosecution story in brief in the FIR as per informant Ranjeet Yadav is that on 29.07.2025, when he was ploughing his field by tractor, then his tractor entered into the field of accused side, due to which the accused/petitioners along with other co-accused lashed with weapon entered into the house of the informant, abusing and attacked upon the informant side. It has been further alleged that petitioner injured the father of the informant with spade(Kudal).

3. Heard Ld. Counsel for the petitioner and Ld. APP for the state.

4. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submit that in the present matter co-accused **Bijendra Yadav @ Vijendra Yadav and Ram Khelawan Yadav has been granted bail by the Hon'ble High Court vide its order dated 03.12.2025** passed in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 78265/2025. He further submits that in para 75 and 195 of the case diary, it has come in the supervision report that the accused/petitioners were not involved in the alleged crime and the allegation against them have been found untrue.

5. Ld. APP vehemently opposes the bail.

6. Considering the fact that other **2 accused has been granted anticipatory bail by Hon'ble High Court** as mentioned here in above **AND** clean antecedent **AND** the material available in para 75 and 195 of case diary,

the prayer for anticipatory bail of accused/petitioners namely **1. Raj Raushan Kumar @ Laltu 2. Parwati Devi @ Savitri Devi 3. Sanjay Yadav 4. Prabhat Yadav @ Prabhat Ranjan 5. Renu Devi 6. Lalita Devi 7. Gulshan Kumar and 8. Kiran Devi is allowed** and they shall be **released on bail** in the event of their arrest or surrender **within four weeks** before the concern trial court with two sureties of Rs. 10000/- of like amount and petitioner shall not intimidate the informant and any witnesses.

7. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that accused/petitioner no 1. Raj Raushan Kumar @ Laltu is willing and would be loving to do some social work and community service for the society. He further submits that since the **accused/petitioner No.1 is a student**, he would like to give free tuition to **10 children of BPL category** of his village. Therefore he is asked to **give free tuition to 10 children up to class 6 of BPL category for 2 hours daily, 5 days in a week for next 6 months** and after completion of every month he will obtain a certificate from the parents of all the children and file the same in the court concern and on completion of 6 months obtain a certificate from the **Mukhiya or Sarpanch or Ward Counselor** of his area and shall file the same in the court concern.

8. Petitioner no. 2 to 8 asked each to **plant 50 each fruit bearing tress or trees like Baniyana, Neem or Bargad (encouraging the Bihar Government Scheme 'JAL JEEVAN HARYALI')** in the public place such as Temple, school etc and shall **take care** of those tress **for next six months** and file the **photographs** of planting of those trees in the court concerned and obtain a certificate from the **Mukhiya or Sarpanch or Ward Counselor** of his area and shall file the same in the court concern.

Accordingly the bail petition is disposed off.
