1. Bail application has been filed on behalf of petitioner namely **Lalan Sharma**, who is **in judicial custody since 13.02.2026** in connection with Saur Bazar P.S Case No. 199/2025 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 74, 303(2), 308(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS.

2. The brief facts of lodging of the present FIR as per of Ramchandra Sharma is that on 13.06.2026 at about 08:00 AM, when he was feeding his cattle then FIR named accused persons including the petitioner lashed with arms and weapons attacked and beaten him causing head injury upon the informant there are other allegations in the FIR.

3. Heard, Ld. Counsel for the petitioner and Ld. APP for the state.

4. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is custody since 13.02.2026 and has clean antecedent. He further submits that in the present matter charge sheet has been submitted and charge has been framed on 03.07.2026 meaning thereby the investigation has been completed and there is no possibility of tempering or hampering the evidences or witnesses. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has a daily wages labourer having 3 children and they are deprived of care and breed earning..

5. Ld. APP vehemently opposes the bail stating that in para 53 the injury report has been mentioned which shows that lacerated would on the skull.

6. Considering the period of of custody since 13.02.2026 and clean antecedent of the petitioner and the fact that the charge sheet has been submitted and charge has been framed the prayer for bail is allowed. And he **is directed to be released on bail** on furnishing of bail bond of Rs. 10000/- with two sureties of like amount.

7. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that accused/petitioner is willing and would be loving to do some social work and community service and offer that the petitioner is ready to give his free service to **Matasgandha Mandir situated in Saharsa** who is near to his house. Therefore the petitioner is asked to give **3 hours free service in said Matasgandha Mandir for 5 days in a week for 6 months** after they shall obtain **a certificate from the manager of the said Matasgandha Mandir** and **file the same in the same court concerned.**

Accordingly the present bail petition is disposed off.
