1. Anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of petitioner namely **1. Sanjay Kumar Singh**, who apprehend his arrest in connection with **Saharsa Sadar P.S Case No. 167/2026** registered under sections 316(2), 316(5), 318(4), 61(2), 3(5) of BNS.

2. The prosecution story as per FIR in brief is that Municipal Corporation, Saharsa filed an application to the Nagar Thana, Saharsa stating that Rahul Kumar Paswan has made a complaint regarding Rajeev Kumar, who is private secretary of Chief Councilor of the Municipal Corporation, Saharsa. It was alleged that said Rajeev Kumar has constituted a company **Nari Shakti Infotech and Development Service Private Limited** in the name of his wife and enter into a consortium with M/S Panther Unit Infrastructure Private Limited and has embezzled crores of Government money.

On such allegation, a three member committee was constituted, which submitted its report and thereafter police was asked to institute an FIR against the persons and agencies involved in the alleged embezzlement, hence present FIR.

3. Heard Ld. Counsel for the petitioner and Ld. APP for the state.

4. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present FIR has been lodged on the basis of 3 member committee report but this 3 member committee was dissolved and scrapped by the order of District Magistrate, Saharsa vide Letter No. 1440 dated 03.07.2025 and a 4 member Committee was constituted for further inquiry in the allegation of said Rahul Kumar Paswan.

5. He further submits that since the basis of the present FIR is 3

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member committee report, which itself has been scrapped by the D.M. Saharsa, therefore the present FIR has no legality.

6. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is a director of M/S Panther Unit Infrastructure private Limited, which entered into consortium with Nari Shakti Infotech and Development Service Private Limited only for to meet the eligibility condition of the tender applied by Nari Shakti Infotech and Development Service Private Limited. He further submits that the company of the petitioner did not had the power of billing for the project obtained by tender and in entire case diary there is no bill, issued by the company of the petitioner.

7. He further submits that 4 member committee, which was constituted after scrapping of 3 member committee, sought a report from the Municipal Commissioner, Saharsa regarding the allegation made by Rahul Kumar Paswan and by letter no. 2877 dated 13.11.2025, **the Municipal Commissioner sent a report that non of the allegation made by Rahul Kumar Paswan was found true.** He further submits that the Petitioner and his company has never raised any invoice and not a single penny was paid by the Municipal Commissioner Saharsa in the account of the petitioner or his company.

8. Ld. APP opposes the bail of the petitioner but on inquiry from this court, he concedes that there is nothing in the case diary which shows that any invoice was issued by the petitioner. He further submits that nothing has come in the case diary showing that any payment was made to the petitioner or his company. He further submits that in the entire case diary, there no much incriminating material is available against the accused/petitioner.

9. Considering the rival submission of both the parties **AND** that no payment was made either to the petitioner or his company **AND** further that no invoice was issued either by the petitioner or his company, the prayer for anticipatory bail of accused/petitioner Sanjay Kumar Singh is **allowed** and

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he shall be **released on bail** in the event of his arrest **or** surrender **within four weeks** before the concern trial court with two sureties of Rs. 10000/- of like amount.

10. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that accused/petitioner is a man of means and is willing and would be loving to do some social work and community service and it would be his pleasure if he does something for the library of Saharsa Bar Association and shows his interest and submits that the petitioner will make the library of Advocate Association, Saharsa a first class library giving all modern facilities which are required for A class and excellent library. Therefore he is asked to make the library of Advocate Association of Saharsa a first class, library with all modern facilities, in consultation with Secretary and President of Advocate Association of Saharsa, within 1 months from this order and obtain a certificate from the Secretary or President of Advocate Association Saharsa and submit the same in the court concern.

According the bail petition is disposed of.
