1. Regular Bail Application No. 160/2026 has been filed on behalf of petitioner namely **1. Murari Yadav @ Gopal Sharan Murari, who is in judicial custody since 20.02.2026**, in connection with Pastpar **P.S Case No. 23/2024** registered under sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 303(2), 109, 333, 352, 351(3), 3(5) and 103(1) of BNS.

AND

Regular Bail Application No. 167/2026 has been filed on behalf of petitioner namely **1. Fulo Yadav @ Ashish Kumar, who is in judicial custody since 24.01.2026**, in connection with Pastpar **P.S Case No. 23/2024** registered under sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 303(2), 109, 333, 352, 351(3), 3(5) and 103(1) of BNS.

AND

Regular Bail Application No. 170/2026 has been filed on behalf of petitioners namely **1. Ganesh Yadav 2. Anil Yadav and 3. Shashi Yadav**, who are **in judicial custody since 25.01.2026**, in connection with Pastpar **P.S Case No. 23/2024** registered under sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 303(2), 109, 333, 352, 351(3), 3(5) and 103(1) of BNS.

By this combined order, all above-mentioned 3 bail application is being disposed off.

2. The prosecution story in the FIR as per informant Ramesh Yadav is that on 05.09.2025 at about 10:30, accused Murari Yadav, Kailash Yadav, Digambar Yadav, Raushan @ Lallu Kumar, Shatyam Kumar, Chandra Kishor Yadav, Devo Kumar, Parsuram Yadav, Mithilesh Yadav, Ganesh Yadav, Kartik Yadav, Anil Yadav, B.P Yadav, Fulo Yadav, Shashi Yadav and Kranti Yadav came at his door and **started firing** and entered into his house and **incarcerated all his family members** while all of them were sleeping in their rooms. Accused Murari Yadav, Kailash Yadav, Mithilesh Yadav and Shatyam

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Kumar armed with weapons **assaulted his family members with butt of pistol and three-nut** as a result, they sustained injury and became unconscious. During course of occurrence, Shashi Yadav, Fulo Yadav, Anil Yadav, BP Yadav, Ganesh yadav, Kartik Yadav, Parsuram Yadav entered into his house and broke open the lock of his box and took away jewellery, cash and documents. On hearing ruckus, villagers assembled at place of occurrence. One of the accused Murari Yadav threatened with dire consequence on point of pistol if he lodges the case.

3. Heard Ld. Counsel for the petitioners and Ld. APP for the state along with Ld. counsel for the informant.

4. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner namely Murari Yadav @ Gopal Sharan Murari submits that, his name was initially dropped in the investigation by SDPO, but later on, in the supervision of S.P, his name was added. He further submits that petitioner Murari Yadav @ Gopal Sharan Murari is a government servant (teacher) and has been falsely implicated in the present matter, as the informant had earlier stated that the petitioner was not involvement in the crime.

5. Ld. Counsel for the accused Fulo Yadav in RBA no. 167/2026 and Ganesh Yadav & ors in RBA no. 170/2026, submits that in the present matter accused Chandrakishor Yadav @ Chandakishor Yadav has been granted bail along with some other accused by Hon'ble High Court.

6. To the granting of Regular and other Bail by Hon'ble High Court, Ld. APP along with counsel for the informant submits that in the present matter **Regular Bail of Digambar Yadav @ Digambar Kumar has been rejected by Hon'ble High Court vide its order dated 19.04.2025** passed in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 6460 of 2025, against which the said accused Digambar Yadav had approached to **Hon'ble Supreme Court, by filling SLP (Criminal No. 14074 of 2025), which was dismissed by Hon'ble Supreme Court.**

7. Perused the record and case diary. On perusal of record, it transpires that Ramesh Yadav, who is the son of the deceased namely Maheshwari Yadav,

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has given his statement u/s 183 BNSS (u/s 164 Cr.P.C) in which he has **categorically taken the name** of the Murari Yadav, Ganesh Yadav, Anil Yadav, Shashi Yadav and Fulo Yadav regarding their involvement in the crime.

8. It is important to mention herein that in Session Trial No. 111/2025 arising out of the same FIR being Pastpar P.S. case no. 23/2024, the **two witnesses namely Chandan Devi and Tetri Devi** has given his statement as PW-1 and PW-2 respectively, in which **both the witnesses has taken the name of all these accused/petitioners** i.e Murari Yadav @ Gopal Sharan Murari, Ganesh Yadav, Anil Yadav, Shashi Yadav and Fulo Yadav regarding their involvement in the crime.

8. Considering the **Judicial discipline** that the regular bail of Digambar Yadav has been rejected by Hon'ble High Court as well as Hon'ble Supreme Court **AND statement of Ramesh Yadav** given u/s 183 BNSS (u/s 164 Cr.P.C) **AND** evidence given by Chandan Devi and widow of deceased Tetri Devi as PW-1 and PW-2 in Session Trial No. 111/2025, this court is **not inclined to grant regular bail** to the above mentioned accused/petitioners, and hence all the above mentioned regular bail application is **hereby rejected**.

Accordingly, all bail applications is disposed off.
