The present anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of accused petitioner namely Vivek Tiwari @ Vivek Kumar Tiwari apprehending his arrest in connection with Saur Bazar PS Case No.-57/2026 for the offences punishable u/s 135 of Electricity Act. Put up for hearing. 2. Heard Sri Sunil Kumar Singh, learned counsel for petitioner as well as Sadanand Yadav, learned A.P.P. for the State. 3. The case of prosecution in brief as per written information of Manish Kumar said to be Junior Electrical Engineer electric supply unit Saur Bazar is that on 20.02.2026 he along with others being member of the team conducted raid at about 03:00 PM reached to the commercial premises of cure health care and trauma centre situated in the premises of Sri Vivek Tiwari having consumer number 105406915604 having smart prepaid meter no.-9022683. Further the allegation against the petitioner is that the said meter was tampered by him and the same resulted into loss to the tune of Rs. 2,24,126/- to the NBPDCCL. 4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner has committed no offence and further submitted that earlier no application has been has been	

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Contd. 23.04.2026	filed in this court or before the Hon'ble High Court. Further he submitted that accused petitioner is having no antecedent having similar allegation. Further he has submitted in para-14 of the bail application he is ready to deposit the outstanding amount of Rs. 2,24,126/- on easy installments and the remaining amount will be deposited in four equal installments in subsequent four months starting from the date of the deposit of the first installment. Lastly, it is stated that the petitioners deserve bail. 5. Learned A.P.P. opposed the prayer for bail. 6. Perused the record. On perusal of the record, it appears that the matter relates to causing loss on account of committing theft of electricity which resulted allegedly in the loss of the amount to the tune of Rs.2,24,126/- to the state exchequer. Further counsel for the petitioner submitted that his client is ready to deposit the amount and to show his bona fide he has stated of making payment of Rs. 70,000/- as first installment and the remaining amount will be deposited in four equal installments to be paid on the first week on subsequent month. Further it appears from para-03 that petitioner is not having any antecedent of similar allegation. 7. Considering the facts and circumstances discussed and also considering the submission made by the counsel the prayer for pre-arrest bail order of Vivek Tiwari @ Vivek Kumar Tiwari is allowed and it is ordered that in the event of arrest/surrender they will	
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Contd. 23.04.2026	be enlarged on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each within four weeks of the receipt of this order to the satisfaction of the learned court below subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) BNSS. Further as per his contention petitioner will deposit the first installment of Rs. 70,000/- prior to his furnishing of bail bond and the remaining amount will be deposited in four equal installments in subsequent four months starting from the date of the deposit of the first installment. Let a copy of this order be sent to the concern Magistrate and to the concerned Electrical Executive Engineer for information as per the aforesaid direction.
