	13.05.2026	This bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely Aadarsh Kumar S/o Nandan Yadav who is in custody since 16.01.2026 in connection with Kanaria P.S. Case No. 06/2026 registered under Sections 25(1-B)a, 26 of the Arms Act. 2. Heard the arguments of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P. for the State. 3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the accused petitioner that petitioner is in custody since 16.01.2026. It is further submitted that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence and he has falsely been implicated in this case due to grudge, malice and dirty village party politics. It is further submitted that nothing has been recovered from the physical and conscious

It is further submitted that petitioner is a man of means and there is no chance of his absconding or tampering with the evidence in this case and he is ready to furnish sound sureties to the full satisfaction of the court. Upon these grounds, the learned counsel prays to grant bail to the petitioner. 4. On the other hand, the learned P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of bail. 5. Rival submissions considered, Record perused. 6. The prosecution case, in short as per the written report of informant Chandan Yadav is that on 15.01.2026 at about 07:00 P.M. in the evening his nephew Aadarsh Kumar in a drunken state was threatening to passersby with a countrymade pistol in his hand. When his brother Nandan Yadav came to know about this, he told him to inform to Police Station and get Aadarsh Kumar arrested otherwise he will do something unpleasant to someone. His brother Nandan Yadav is living outside in Delhi and works as labourer. Then he caught Adarh Kumar with a countrymade pistol and informed the police station. On receiving the information the police immediately came alongwith armed force and on request of his elder brother Nandan Yadav arrested Aadarsh Kumaqr with a countrymade pistol. 7. The petitioner is in custody since 16.01.2026. The petitioner bears no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 3 of his bail application. As per the allegation the illegal

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countrymade pistol has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. Charge-sheet has already been filed.

8. Considering the totality of the facts and circumstances a case to grant bail to the petitioner accused namely Aadarsh Kumar is made out. Resultantly the prayer for bail is **allowed**. The petitioner be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate where the case is presently pending further subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 480(3) of the BNSS.
