1. Anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of petitioners namely **1. Chandeshwari Ray and 2. Pramila Devi**, who apprehend their arrest in connection with **Bihra P.S Case No. 97/2015** registered u/s 341, 323, 327, 324, 354(A) r/w 34 of IPC.

2. The prosecution story in brief in the FIR as per informant Rita Devi is that on 18.05.2015, at about 1:00 PM, when the informant was sitting in his courtyard, then both the accused came and started abusing and petitioner no. 1 Chandeshwari Ray thrown the informant on the floor by pulling her with hair and caused injury on her head.

3. Heard Ld. Counsel for the petitioners and Ld. APP for the state.

4. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submit that the petitioners were granted police bail, which has come in para 25 of the case diary and stated that the petitioners have never misused the police bail. He further submits that vide D.B. no. 61, dated 29.01.2026, BW was issued against the petitioners but before this that they had no knowledge about the filling of charge-sheet and issuance of summons against them.

5. Ld. APP vehemently opposes the bail petition.

6. Considering the fact that petitioner were on police bail and have never misused the same **AND** having clean antecedent, the prayer for anticipatory bail of accused/petitioners namely 1. Chandeshwari Ray and 2. Pramila Devi is **allowed** and they shall be **released on bail** in the event of their arrest **or** surrender **within four weeks** before the concern trial court with two sureties of Rs. 10000/- of like amount.

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7. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submit that accused/petitioners are willing and would be loving to do some social work and community service for the society. Therefore they are asked to give free service to **Shiv Mandir, Panchgachia** for **2 hours everyday, 5 days in week for next 5 months** and after completion of every month they will obtain a certificate from **main Pujari or trusty** of the said temple, and submit the same in the court concern.

According the bail petition is disposed of.
