	23.05.2026	This bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely Raj Kishor Yadav S/o Suresh Yadav who is in custody since 13.03.2026 in connection with Kanaria P.S. Case No. 20/2026 registered under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(2), 109(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS, 2023. 2. Heard the arguments of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P. for the State. 3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the accused petitioner that petitioner is in custody since 13.03.2026. It is further submitted that petitioner bears criminal antecedent of one case. It is further submitted that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence and he has falsely been implicated in this case. It is further submitted that there is case and counter case between the parties. It is further submitted that petitioner is a man of means and there is no chance of his absconding or tampering with the evidence and he is ready to furnish sound sureties to the full satisfaction of the court. Upon these grounds, the learned counsel prays to grant bail to the petitioner.	

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4. On the other hand, the learned P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of bail.

5. Rival submissions considered, Record perused.

6. The prosecution case, in short as per the written report of informant Koshil Yadav is that on 23.02.2026 at about 04:00 O'clock at the time of spreading fertilizer in his field Ravindra Yadav, Rajkishor Yadav, Vikendra Yadav, Suresh Yadav and Rahul Yadav hiding themselves in the nearby maize field with intention of killing. At the time of spreading fertilizer on the order of Chandeshwari Yadav Ravindra Yadav assaulted on his head by sharp edged weapon. When his brother Arvind came to rescue him then he was also assaulted by Ravindra Yadav and Rajkishor Yadav due to which he sustained injury and fell down. When Sanoj Yadav, the brother of Arvind Yadav came to rescue him then Ravindra Yadav order to kill him. On which Ravindra Yadav and Rahul Yadav assaulted on his head due to which blood started oozing. When Manish Yadav came to rescue them then Ravindra Yadav and Rahul Yadav assaulted on his head by but butt of illegal weapon and farsa with intention of killing due to which he also sustained injury. When Manish Yadav came to rescue him then he was also assaulted due to which he became unconscious. Thereafter six persons on three motor-cycle went to kill his father and uncle with intention of killing on which he also chased them. In the meantime the accused persons assaulted his father and uncle at the Yagya sthan by iron rod with intention of killing. On raising alarm the nearby people came there and the injured were brought to Simri Bakhtiyarpur Hospital for treatment.

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7. The petitioner is in custody since 13.03.2026. As per the allegation against the petitioner and other co-accused assaulted and attacked the informant and other injured at the field. It is alleged that thereafter the petitioner and co-accused went to yagyasthal to assault the other family members of informant.

8. There are five injured persons. Out of which three of the injured persons have sustained grievous injuries. The allegations are serious in nature. The incident is not of the type which occurs at the spur of the moment. In the instant case, firstly the petitioner and other co-accused persons assaulted the informant side at the field and thereafter they proceeded to the Yagyasthal and also assaulted the family members of the informant there.

9. If released on bail at this stage the petitioner may influence the witnesses and tampered with the evidence.

8. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, no case is made out to admit the petitioner on bail. Resultantly, the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner Raj Kishor Yadav is hereby **rejected**. The petitioner may renew his prayer for bail after filing of charge-sheet, if the petitioner wish to do so.

9. With the aforesaid observations, the petition stands disposed of. Dictated)
