1. Anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of petitioner namely **1. Ashok Das**, who apprehends his arrest in connection with **Simri Bakhtiyarpur P.S Case No. 252/2025** registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109, 118(1), 303(2), 352, 351(2), and 3(5) of BNS.

2. The brief facts in the FIR as per informant Bharat Das, is that on 15.08.2025 at about 04:05 PM, the accused/petitioner along with others started abusing the father of the informant and attacked on him. It has further been alleged that accused/petitioner Ashok Das and Arvind Das had caused **head injury** with iron rod and thrown his sister on the ground and took golden chain and also demanded rangdari.

3. Heard Ld. counsel for the petitioner and Ld. APP for the State.

4. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence and he has falsely been implicated in the present case and there is a case and cross case between the parties and there is no possibilities of amicable settlement between both the sides.

5. Ld. APP strongly and vehemently opposes the bail stating that in the present matter 2 persons have been injured including one woman namely Amirkia Devi and both **have been seriously injured** having injury **on vital part** of the body.

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6. Perused the record and case diary. On perusal of case diary, injury report of injured Amirka Devi, are as follows:-

(I) Lacerated wound over sup part of right parietal region of vertex size 2" X ¼" Skin deep

Injury report of injured Debendra Das, are as follows:-

(I) lacerated wound over right anti vertex size 1" X ¼" Skin deep

(ii) Lacerated wound on left anti vertex size 3" X ¼" skin deep

(iii) Lacerated wound over sup vertex size 2" X ¼" Skin deep.

7. Considering the statement of witnesses **AND** Injury being on the vital part of the body, this court **is not inclined** to grant anticipatory bail to the accused/petitioner namely **Ashok Das**, hence his prayer for anticipatory bail is hereby **rejected**.

Accordingly the present bail petition is disposed off.
